In accordance with regulation § 9.4 in BWF Statutes, Section 5.3.3.2: World Junior Ranking System, an event must contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw. If an event does not contain at least 1 (one) entry from a Member other than the hosting Member in the first published version of the main draw, this particular event shall not count towards any ranking.

Tournament Regulations / Courts

All matches will be played on 6 approved Badminton YONEX Court Mats according to a fixed schedule. The knock-out system will be used. Rejections and the schedule for the tournament will be published successively.

All players should be ready to play 30 minutes before their scheduled match.

Changes in the draw and schedule are possible. They will be posted as early as possible and affected players will also be informed in time.

Eligible Players

All badminton players who are eligible to play for BWF members.

Players cannot be entered unless they already have a BWF ID-number. Entries can only be submitted by Member Associations.

The online entry page will close immediately on **Tuesday, 3rd of February 2026 – 23:59 h BWF Headquarters time (GMT +08:00)** and you are required to submit the entries on time.

No late entries will be accepted.

GCR 7.9: In making or authorising entries, the member concerned is reconfirming its acceptance, and acceptance by the players being entered, of the BWF's regulations and disciplinary processes.

Drug testing will be implemented according to BWF tournament regulations.

Stringing Service

During the event stringing service will be present.

Practice Hall

Sports hall of St.-Antonius-Gymnasium, Hinterm Hagen 82, 59348 Lüdinghausen

(1,1 km walking distance to the venue – 15 min.) We will offer a shuttle service.

The sports hall is open on Monday from 3 p.m. to 9 p.m. and on Tuesday from 8 a.m. to 9 p.m.

Warm up facilities

Unfortunately, there will be no separate warm-up courts available in the main hall.

There will be a gymnastics room for warming up and small practicing.

If you wish to use the open practice hall for warm-ups, please make sure you arrive at the main hall on time. 30 minutes before the scheduled match.

Catering

A cafeteria offering hot and cold snacks and drinks. It will be available during the whole tournament. Food trucks are planned to be set up outside the arena to provide hot meals for all guests. No booking in advance is necessary.

Lüdinghausen also offers a variety of restaurants near the main hall.

Clothing & Advertising Regulations

Colour, design, lettering and advertising on clothing shall be regulated by BWF Statutes.

Section 5.2.3: Junior Tournament Regulations § 12 to 16. A player violating these regulations shall be penalised by an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

It is mandatory for the semi-finals and finals that partners in doubles wear the same colour of the T-shirt and shorts/skirts. Failing to do so shall result in an administrative fine of 50,00 EUR.

The decision of the referee is final.

Visa

It is the responsibility of the Member Association to apply for the necessary visas in sufficient time, and all matters should be directed to the Embassy in charge. Any visa support letter issued by the tournament host does not guarantee entry into Germany;

the final decision is made the Government of Germany. It is the responsibility of any nation or player if a visa is needed to travel to Germany to send the visa applications

The tournament host and hosting Member Association will only communicate with a Member Association, and the hosting Member Association will only provide a visa support letter if the form is completed accurately and comprehensively, and supporting documentation is provided, where requested.

Please let us know all needed details by using the Visa Application Form. German Badminton Association will be unable to send supporting letters at a late stage. It also could be problem for German Embassies to issue "last minute" visas.

Transport

Transport will be provided from **Münster Osnabrück International Airport**, **Train Station Dülmen** and **Train Station Lüdinghausen**. Unfortunately, the airport Münster Osnabrück offers only a few international flight destinations.

So, most associations will arrive at Düsseldorf International Airport (DUS).

We cannot offer a shuttle service from or to this airport (DUS).

However, you can take a direct train from the airport to Dülmen train station, with connections every hour or every half hour with one train change. In Dülmen you can use our shuttle service.

This is the fastest way to reach us. A shuttle service by bus would take significantly longer.

If you wish, we can arrange transport through an external service provider at your expense.

We can request a quote for this transport if needed.

Only people who have registered via the transport request form can use the shuttle service.

Please use the transport request form and return it to us **until the 14th of February 2026**.

Accommodation

To offer accommodation to all participants, we have reserved 6 hotels for the tournament until January 2nd, 2026. The hotels have different categories and prices.

We offer a shuttle service to the main hall only for guests staying at these hotels.

Please note we act only as a mediator. You conclude the contract directly with the hotel.

The hotel will bill the fees to your association. We will not pay cancellation fees.

First association to answer will be served first!
